## United Nations Association of Minnesota Global Classrooms Program 2012 Evaluation Summary

## Student Self-Assessment

This was designed to capture some of the more intangible benefits of the Global Classrooms program. Of the 1,867 students that participated in the survey, $49 \%$ reported improved academic skills and $72 \%$ reported an increased awareness of international issues. This data will be used to continue to refine the program next year.


1. I am better able to consider multiple sides of an important international issue. (65.93\% Strongly Agree or Agree, 28.76\% Neutral, and 3.96\% Disagree or Strongly Disagree)
2. I am more aware of other countries' perspectives on important international issues. ( $\mathbf{7 5 . 5 8 \%}$ Strongly Agree or Agree, 19.87\% Neutral, and 3.54\% Disagree or Strongly Disagree)
3. I am more aware of international issues than before. (75.09\% Strongly Agree or Agree, 19.23\% Neutral, and 4.45\% Disagree or Strongly Disagree)
4. My research skills have improved. (54.90\% Strongly Agree or Agree, 35.46\% Neutral, and 8.36\% Disagree or Strongly Disagree)
5. My ability to actively participate in a discussion has increased. (57.20\% Strongly Agree or Agree, 32.14\% Neutral, and $9.32 \%$ Disagree or Strongly Disagree)
6. My writing skills have improved. (40.39\% Strongly Agree or Agree, 43.22\% Neutral, and $14.94 \%$ Disagree or Strongly Disagree)
7. I am more comfortable speaking in public. (42.47\% Strongly Agree or Agree, 36.58\% Neutral, and 19.76\% Disagree or Strongly Disagree)

## Teacher Evaluation



The 2012 Global Classrooms Teacher Evaluation was designed to assess the quality and benefit of the program as perceived by participating teachers. The following is based on 40 received evaluations.

1. Quality of Global Classrooms materials: $65 \%$ Excellent, 27.5\% Above Average, 5\% Average, and 0\% Below Average or Poor
2. Content of Global Classrooms materials: $65 \%$ Excellent, 25\% Above Average, 7.5\% Average, and 0\% Below Average or Poor
3. Students' understanding of the United Nations and its role after the completion of the program: $35 \%$ Excellent, 42.5\% Above Average, 17.5\% Average, 2.5\% Below Average, and 0\% Poor
